Immediately to the Right
Daily rentals to the public

Do not go there

Group Sales Office: Peggy Lee is the director who arranges the discounts Big Foot Recreation receives for the Friday skiing.

Tracy's desk is on the opposite side of the hallway from group sales.



The end of the corridor:

Upstairs for the foot court, bar and observation deck

Left for the slopes and private instruction

Right for lockers, bathrooms and rentals.

Group Lessons Proceed past Rentals and out the door for **START at 4:45 pm**



At the stairwell facing right:

Following the corral for boot rentals

Straight ahead for lockers and changing area



Entering the corral for rentals:

First boot rentals



Boot rental counter:

Make sure you have your **rental form** for the first time of the season, **or** your **season pass** for the remainder of the season.

Your season pass has your rental information on it.



Helmet Rental:

If you did not rent a helmet, proceed down the hallway for equipment rentals



Ski and Snowboard Rentals:

Once you have your equipment, proceed down the hallway for lessons or hit the slopes



Outside from equipment rentals:

Beginner hills to the right

Intermediate hill straight ahead

Advanced hill to the left



Group lessons outside from rentals:

For skiers and snowboarders

Starts at 4:45 – Don't be late



Locker area:

By the rental area. Bring a few quarters to rent them



Upstairs at the snack shop:

Great variety of snacks and sandwiches available. Large area to hang out and play video games – overlooks the ski slopes.

Opposite side – bar which also overlooks the slopes
